

What to Wear to a Dance Audition/Call:

WOMEN:

Jazz Dance Call

1. Color Leotard – a bright color that plays up your skin color.
 - a) High Cut/French Cut – makes your legs look longer
 - b) Bring an extra leotard of a different color. Just in case someone else is wearing the same color, you can change.
2. Tan Tights – NO PINK. You can wear black, but they really want to see the way your body moves and black hides that.
 - a) Make sure to hike them up. You don't want to have any lines.
3. Character Shoes – Make sure they are at least 2/2 ½ in. tall and you can DANCE in them. If you are wearing tan tights wear tan character shoes. If you are wearing black tights wear black character shoes. Under no circumstance should you wear black tights with tan shoes. Black shoes with tan tights are acceptable.
4. Skirt – For Women only. Bring one into the room, but you don't necessarily have to wear it. Some combinations will call for the use of a skirt. But it is not necessary.
5. Hair – MUST BE COMPLETELY OUT OF YOUR FACE!
 - a) For Long Hair – Pony tail; Half up, Half Down; Braid
 - b) For Short Hair – A poof on the top; Pulled back as much as possible.
 - c) All Wisps and bangs must be completely pinned back.
 - d) No buns unless it is specified.
 - e) Hairspray is a wonderful invention. Learn to love it!

Ballet Dance Call

1. Color Leotard – (same as above) Unless it is specified to wear black
 - a) Bring a black one just in case.
 - b) Bring an extra color leotard too.
2. Pink Tights – No tan or black. Must be Pink.
3. Ballet Shoes – canvas or leather, which ever you prefer.
 - a) Make sure the elastic is sewn and the shoes fit you.
 - b) Bring your pointe shoes in the room, if you are on pointe.
4. Ballet skirt – Not required, but a good idea to have.
5. Hair – In a bun or as much in a bun as possible. No other exceptions. No fly aways or wisps. Should be slick and clean looking.

All Dance Calls

1. No Jewelry. At All.
2. Bring all types of shoes to your audition. You may or may not need them all.

What to Wear to a Dance Audition/Call:

MEN:

Jazz Dance Call

1. Fitted Jazz Pants – Always pulled up and at the waist.
 - a) Should be black
2. Fitted t-shirt – COLOR! Find a color that looks good on you. You want to stand out.
 - a) Should have sleeves.
 - b) If it is not fitted, take a hair ties and tie it at the back and tuck it into your pants.
3. Character Shoes/Jazz Shoes – Should be black and fit you.
 - a) Bring jazz sneakers as well, in case you are doing hip hop.

Ballet Dance Call

1. Black Footed Tights – Makes your legs look very long and gives you a clean line.
2. Black Ballet Shoes – Make sure the elastic is sewn.
 - a) If you plan to wear white tights, make sure you wear white ballet shoes as well.
3. White Fitted Shirt – As in Underarmor. Must have sleeves (in case of partnering)
 - a) You can bring a bright color fitted t-shirt if there is not a set rule for the color of the shirt.

All Dance Calls

1. No Jewelry. At All.
2. Hair – Must be completely out of your face.
 - a) Headbands are your friend. As well, as a bobby pins.
