

## **What to Wear to a Singing/Acting Audition:**

### **WOMEN:**

1. Heels – Tall heels. Should be able to do a double pirouette in them. The taller the shoes are, the taller they make you look and skinnier it makes you look.  
**\*\*NOT CHARACTER SHOES\*\***
2. Dress, Skirt, or Dress Pants – No Jeans. Make sure they are tasteful, not too short or too tight. Can wear black pants, but I don't suggest a completely black dress. You need some color to make you stand out.  
**\*\*Play up your assets\*\***
3. Dress Shirt – If you wear a skirt or pants, make sure to wear a color shirt and one that looks good on you. A good color and a good fit are essential.
4. Hose – If you wear a dress or skirt, you **MUST** wear hose. It is highly advised to also wear hose under your dress pants as well. Hose give your legs a nice sheen.  
**\*\*DO NOT WEAR TIGHTS\*\***
5. Make-Up – Make sure to play up your eyes, “They are the window to the soul.” Not too much, or else you will look too made up. You still want to look like yourself.
6. Hair – It must look nice and be done! Must be out of your face, no bangs hanging down. Completely out of your eyes and make sure it is secure enough that you will not be playing with it at the audition.
7. Jewelry – Necklace, earrings, and a ring are fine. Make sure it is not gaudy. Must be tasteful and matching.
9. Tattoos – **HIDE ALL TATTOOS!** The adjudicators do not want to see them.
8. Look Professional – The entire idea of an outfit is to look professional, but also look like yourself. If you look like a slob, that is how you will come across to the adjudicators. If you look put together, they will focus more on your audition, rather than what you are wearing. Also, be comfy. Don't wear anything that is going to make you feel self conscious. You have enough to worry about without worrying about your clothes.

## **MEN:**

1. Dress Slacks – NO JEANS! Can be solid, but pinstripe makes you look taller and more lean. Always a good thing in this business.  
\*\*ABSOLUTELY NO SAGGING!! Get a belt that matches\*\*
2. Button Down Shirt – A full button down, in a color that looks good on you. Everyone has white, make yourself stand out! Make sure it is fitted and pressed. If you have wrinkles, it makes you look sloppy.  
\*\*Shirt must be tucked in\*\*      \*\*You can roll the cuffs of the shirt if you want\*\*
3. Nice Dress Shoes – No tennis shoes or loafers. Remember you are trying to look professional. Make sure if you're wearing black pants, you should also be wearing black shoes. The same goes for brown. Color coordinate!
4. Socks – Dress socks and they must match your pants.
5. Minimum Jewelry – maybe one piece, but not recommended at all.
6. Hair – It must be done and out of your face.
7. Look Professional – The entire idea of an outfit is to look professional, but also look like yourself. If you look like a slob, that is how you will come across to the adjudicators. If you look put together, they will focus more on your audition, rather than what you are wearing. Also, be comfy. Don't wear anything that is going to make you feel self conscious. You have enough to worry about without worrying about your clothes.
